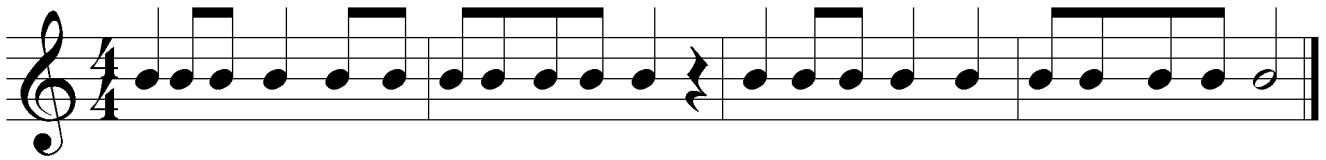

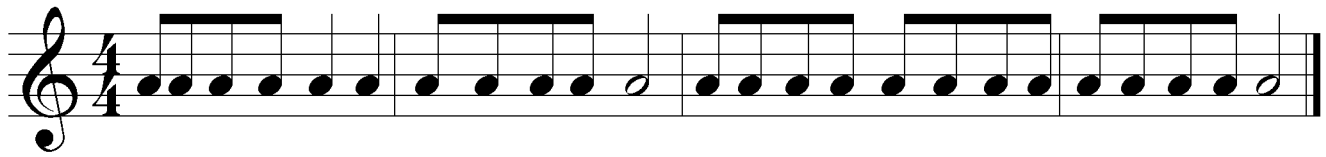

The "B" Song *(Circle the quarter rest.)*



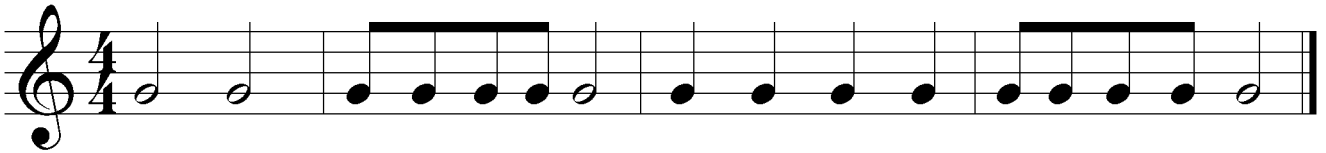
B is the first note, the e-asy one to play. One fin-ger, one thumb, I could play all day.

The "G" Song *(Circle the Treble Clef.)*

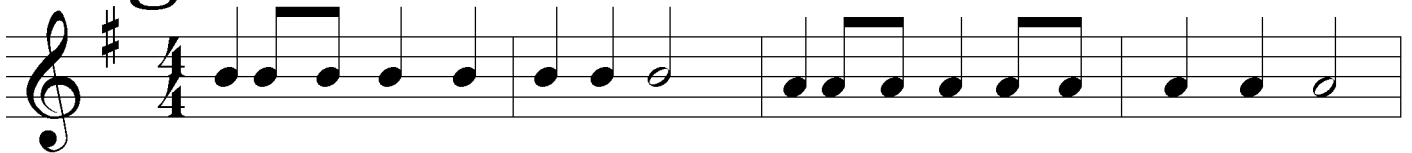
